Read the areas correctly. The named area is the proposed external footprint of enclosed rooms. Courtyard 28 has an additional 18.80 m² open courtyard within its plan envelope; Pavilion 40 has a 12 m² open central court. Terraces and landscaping are separate.

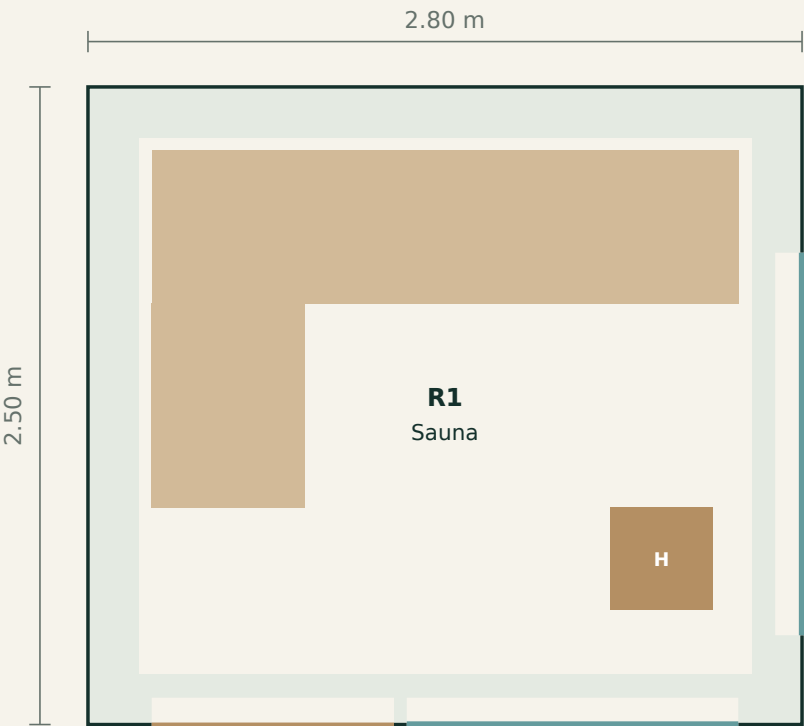
