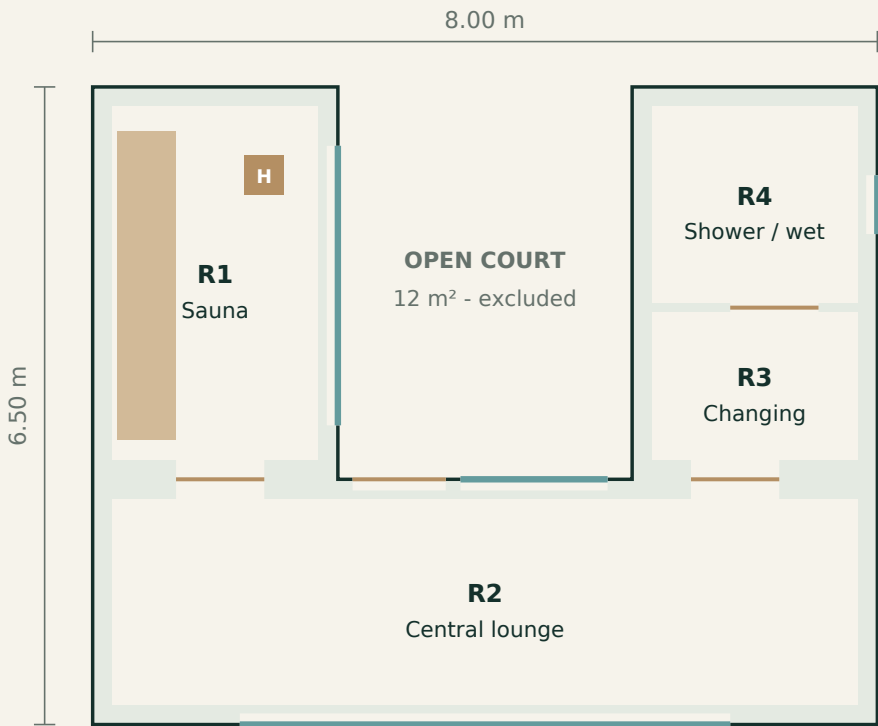
Proposed module count

Clear room zones total: 30.87 m². These are proposed rectangular floor zones, excluding walls, joints and doorway reveals. They are not a statutory measured usable-area statement.

Proposed height: 2.80 m overall and 2.40 m clear inside. Overall plan dimensions exclude terraces, eaves and decorative projections. Bench form, seating capacity, heater specification and final door clearances remain to be confirmed.

The plan envelope includes the open court. Use the enclosed footprint, not length × width, when comparing these models. Additional site space is needed for access, maintenance and any required setbacks.

MATERIALS & YOUR PROJECT

Make it personal. Make it clear.

The palette below describes the proposed design direction. Your quotation defines the actual materials, equipment, finishes and included work.

Interior timber	Thermo-aspen is the proposed sauna finish direction. Coordinated timber finishes can extend into adjacent rooms.
Benches and light	Rounded bench edges, considered backrests and concealed warm lighting are design intentions. Final joinery, fittings and positions are specified in the offer.
Glazing	Multi-aspect central lounge and panoramic sauna glazing. Final glass construction, framing, tint and thermal performance are selected for the sauna and destination.
Exterior	Two-wing timber pavilion with a central glazed lounge. Agree timber species, finish, weathering preference and maintenance requirements using physical samples.
Configuration	Wet-room finishes and interior palette; Wing orientation, lounge joinery and external terrace. Changes remain subject to technical review and the final written scope.

Price and delivery

Project quotation. Prices, taxes, delivery charges and lead times are not yet published. Obtain a written, destination-specific offer before committing.

The offer should separate the sauna supply, options, transport, lifting, foundations, site assembly and utility connections. Local approvals, landscaping, decking and loose furniture are included only when listed. Delivery and installation availability must be confirmed for your location.

Before you request an offer

- 01 Share your country, postcode, site photos and preferred position; identify the view and any privacy needs.
- 02 Describe desired use, number of users and any mobility needs. Capacity and step-free access need a reviewed layout.
- 03 Identify access for unloading, electrical supply and, for wet rooms, water, drainage and winter-use requirements.
- 04 Confirm your preferred model, finishes, budget and timing; ask for the full scope, maintenance guidance and warranty terms in writing.
